

As lawyers, artists and PMs, we are requesting a meeting with the Ministry of Justice;

This request is for a young girl who is near death in front of your ministry. We have heard that there has been a hunger strike in front of your ministry for about 9 months. We have learned that you are the addressee of their demands and that is why they are doing this action in front of your door. Of course, we have a request to meet with whichever institution is authorized in this matter.

We think that if one puts their life on the line and is starving a little more every day, this situation should be intervened in a constructive way. Not seeing such an intervention raises many questions for us. Starvation, especially for more than 200 days, is a very difficult and painful experience. This raises the question: why would someone who is not righteous and who thinks that their demands cannot be met would engage in a struggle for rights by suffering such pain, melting day by day and putting their lives on the line? Eda Deniz Haydaroglu states that she is right and that her demands can be met.

Our main goal is to ensure that a young girl lives. We don't want her to give her life for a struggle for rights. We want to discuss her demands with you and we want steps to be taken so that she can live.

We are not discussing here whether the hunger strike is right or not. 4 people are on hunger strike in front of your Ministry and it is very disturbing that the authorities and state institutions remain insensitive to this. As far as we know, there is no similar example in Germany. We have learned that one of the 4 hunger strikers, Eda Deniz Haydaroglu, is in critical condition. The fact that she has already been starving for 9 months (we have learned that she has survived this long thanks to vitamin B1) shows that she does not have much time.

We don't want to witness a young girl dying in front of our eyes and we don't want to take this situation for granted.
